Introduction: In store locator for Magento 2 your customer finds and locate your physical stores on google map with various search criteria. Customer can perform search for a nearby physical store with criteria's like within a radius, by zip code or city/state to get all the necessary details and exact location of the offline store. When purchasing store pickup, Store Locator users only need to pay the differences between the price of store pickup extension & that of store locator.


Admin can add all needed store information such as address, contact, info, website, tags, image etc. He can also permute stores with customer pin, banner, embedded form (HTML & WYSIWYG supported). Admin have to set store's open time and days off flexibly & also set default search criteria for better experience of customer.

- Magento store locator extension is 100% open source
- No license key required (License certificate is valid for 1 live Magento installation and unlimited test Magento installations).







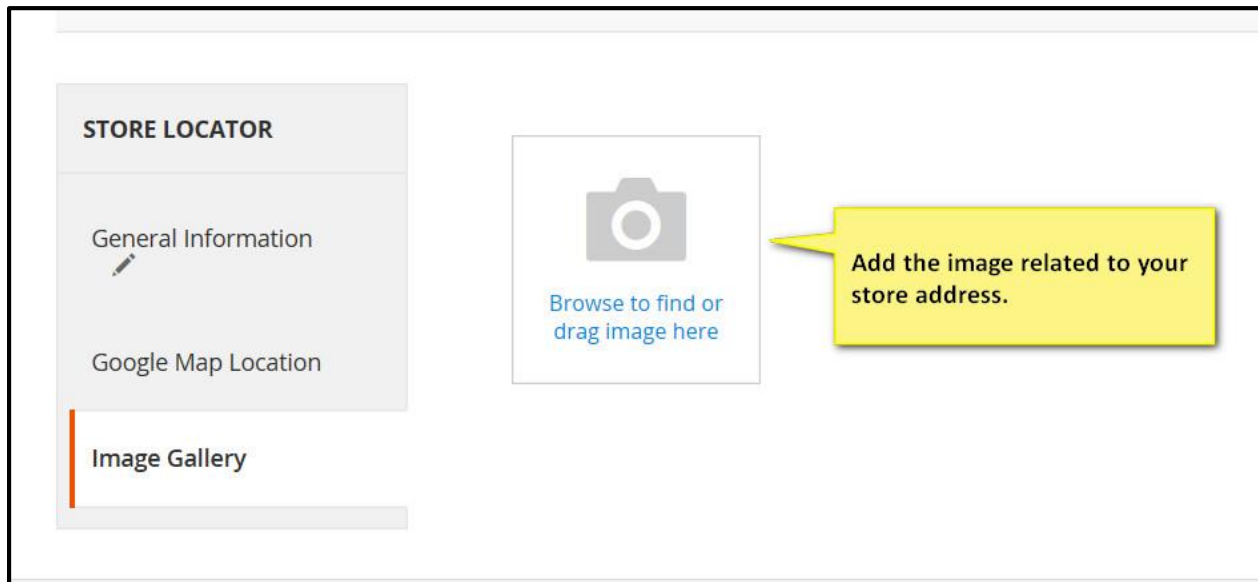



Figure 1.5 – Image Gallery

2 Home Page:

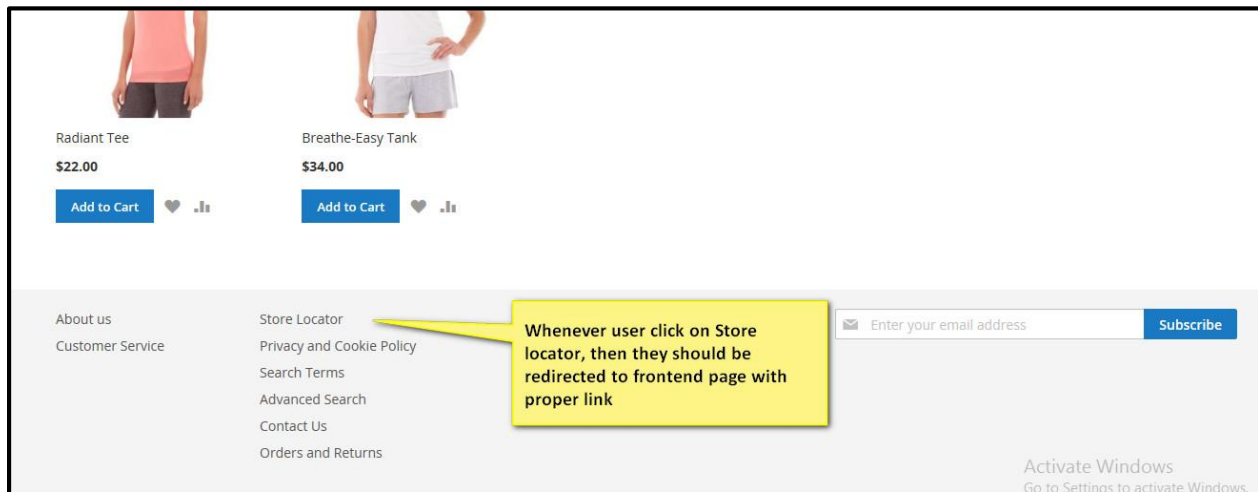


Figure 2.3 – Home Page

2.1 List of stores:

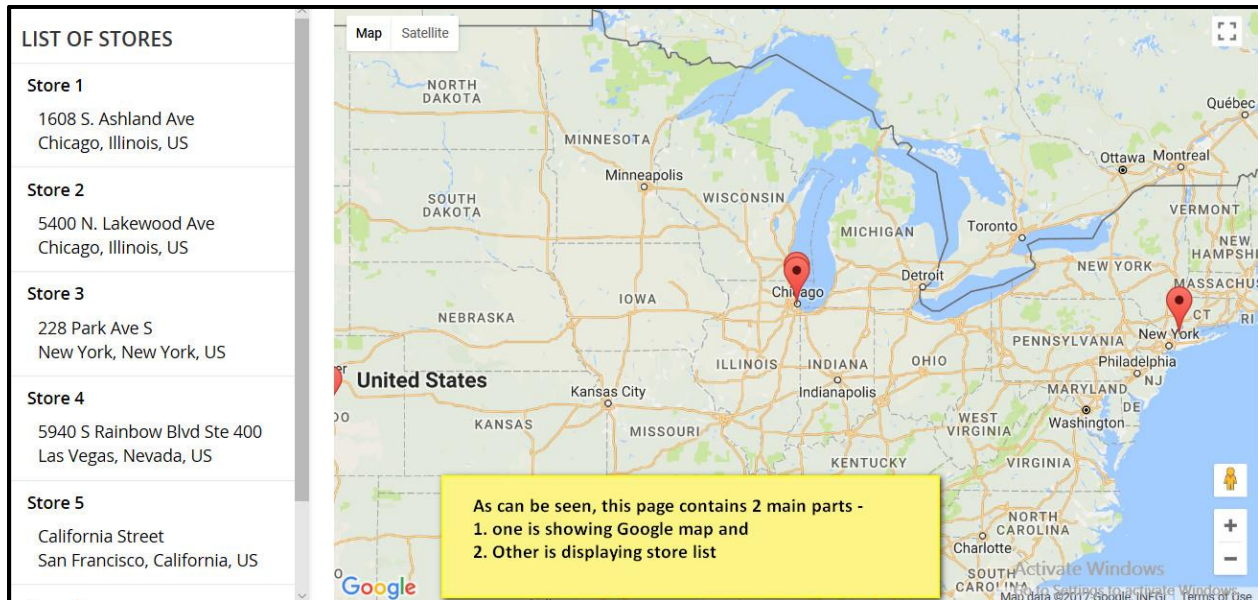


Figure 2 – List of stores

- As can be seen this page is divided into two main parts:
 - List of Stores and
 - Google Map
- ❖ **On the Store list page, Customers can search for most suitable store in many ways:**
 - Search by distance (e.g. within 15 kilometers customer's current location)
 - Search by area (e.g. within a specific state/province, country, city, zip code)
 - Filter stores by tag such as -
 - Available accommodity like free Wi-Fi, convenient parking lot, home delivery, etc.
 - Product/service lines like: women & kids, Health care, sports, coffee

2.1.1 List of stores:

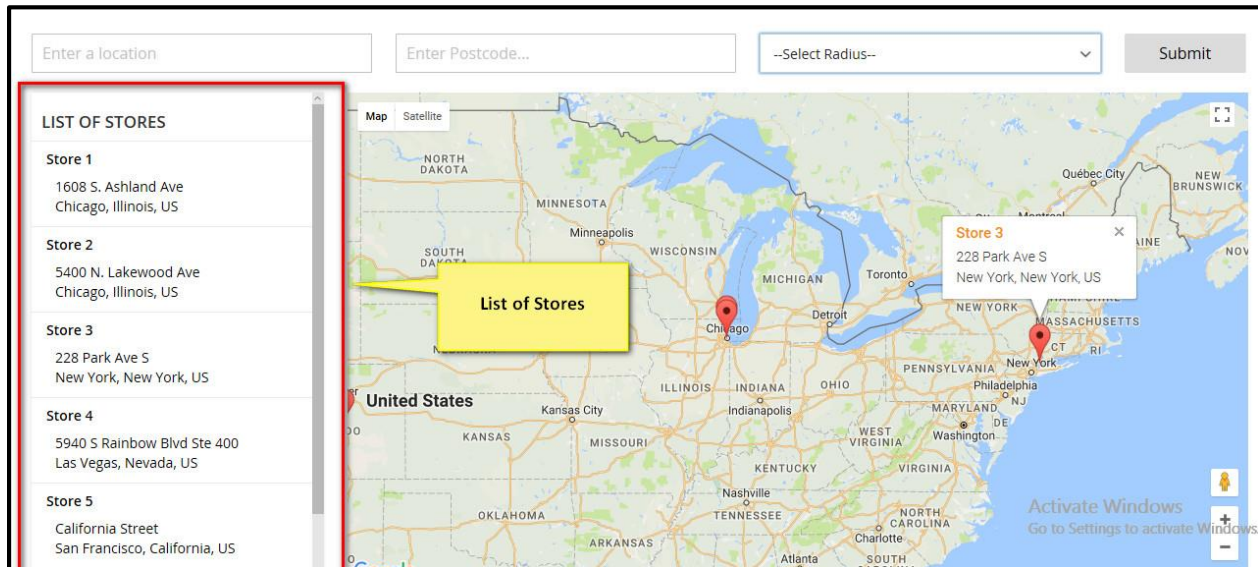


Figure 2.1.1 List of stores

- List of stores part shows all stores of your site on both **store list and Google map**. Each store is shown with name, address, street view, direction link and store image etc.
- Customer can **click on any store**, they want to know more in details

2.1.2 List of stores:

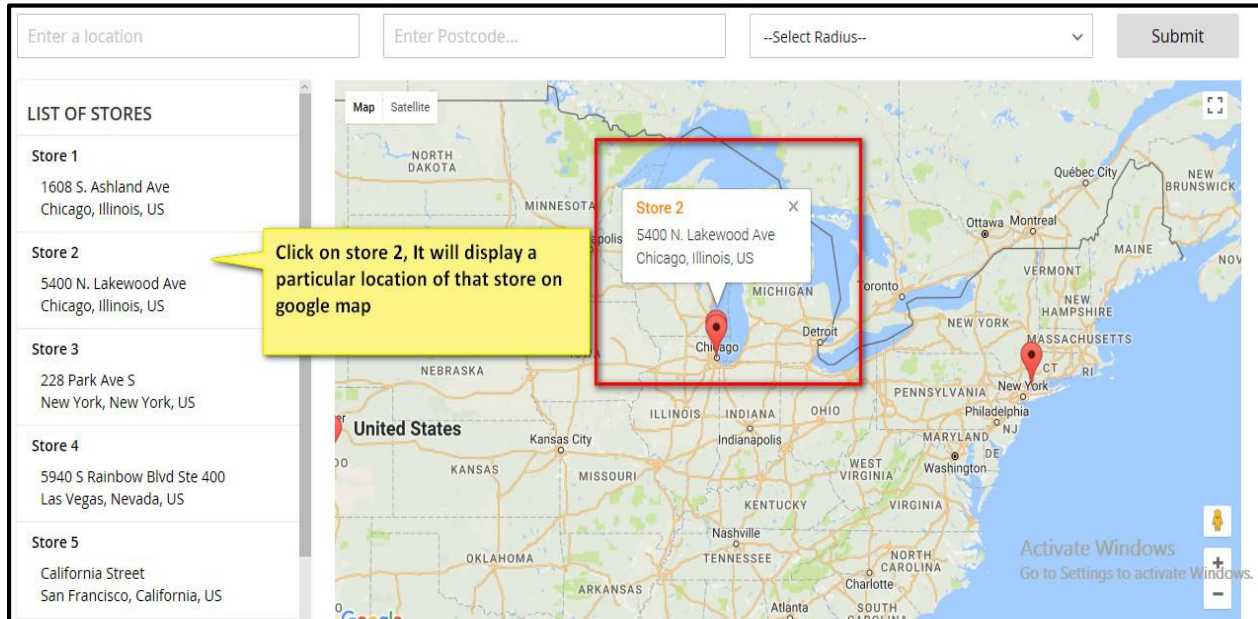


Figure 2.1.2 – List of stores

- When customer **click on a store** on a list, its location is marked on the map by a **colored pin**
- **For example:** Click on store 2, it will display a particular location of that store on Google map.

2.2 Google Map:

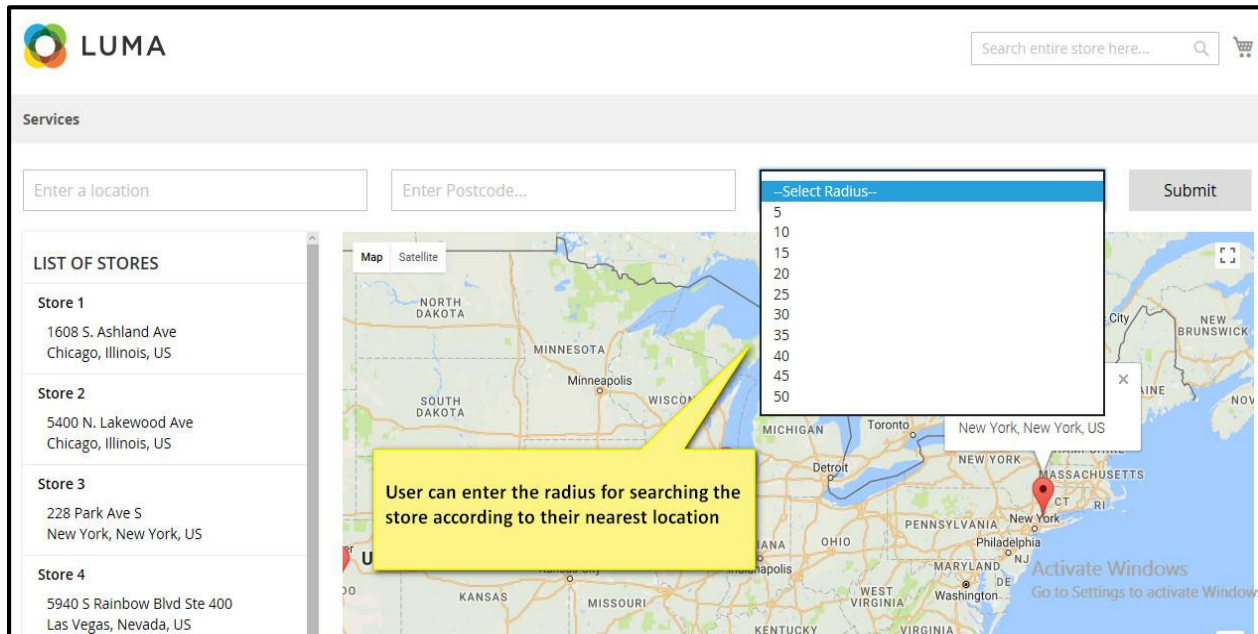


Figure – 2.2 Google map

- In the section of **Google map**, while searching for the store user can select the radius from the dropdown according to their **nearest location**.
- After entered the data, remember to click on **submit button**.
